Civilian Conservation Corps

Provided jobs for single males on conservation projects

Federal Emergency Relief Administration

Helped states to provide aid for the unemployed

Public Works Administration

Created jobs on government projects

Built schools and community buildings

Civil Works Administration

Bigger than PWA

 Provided work on municipal buildings such as stadiums and schools

•40000 schools paid teachers

Emergency Banking Relief Administration

 Banks were closed and inspected by the treasury department. Only strong banks could reopen.

Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation

 Protected bank deposits up to \$5000

Created by the Glass Steagall Act

National IndustrialRecovery Administration

Established codes of fair competition-

 Created the NRA- The Right to Unionize

Agricultural Adjustment Act

• Aided farmers and regulated crop production

Tennessee Valley Authority

 Developed the Tennessee Valley- brought electricity and regulated water in the area

Home Owners Loan Corporation

 Loaned money at low interest to homeowners who could not meet mortgage payments

Federal Housing Administration

More loans for home mortgages and repairs- still around today

Federal Securities Act/Securities and Exchange Commission

- Companies had to provide complete information on stock offerings and made them liable for any misrepresentations.
- SEC- Regulates the stock market
